COVID SPRING BOOSTER

Oakley Health Group patients who are residents in care homes will be vaccinated before Easter.

We have sent out invites to our eligible patients to come to vaccination clinics which will start from the week commencing 17th April.

We have enough vaccine & appointments to vaccinate everyone who is eligible. Once you have booked your appointment with the surgery you can ignore any further invites by the NHS.

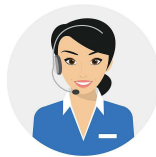


Frank O'Connell (Paramedic Practitioner) has become our Veteran's lead.

April is Bowel Cancer Awareness Month

If you are aged between 60 and 74, you will be invited to take part in bowel cancer screening every two years. The age for testing is due to be extended to include people aged 50-59 over the next 4 years.

If you are aged 75 or over, you can ask for a screening test by calling the free bowel cancer screening helpline on 0800 707 60 60.



HAY FEVER - FEXOFENDINE

Fexofenadine is known as a non-drowsy antihistamine.

For hay fever, the 120mg dose of Fexofenadine is available to buy over the counter & will no longer be prescribed by a GP.
