

Connected Care Data Analytics

Oakley Health Group is now uploading information from GP records to the Connected Care (Share Your Care) database for *secondary purposes*. Detailed information from your GP medical record will be extracted and uploaded to the database, for which Graphnet Ltd. is the data processor. For the GP records uploaded, Oakley Health Group is the data controller.

Information about you from hospital trusts, community services, social care records and mental health services will also be extracted, uploaded, and combined with your GP data.

That combined/linked record is then further transferred to Microsoft UK, where the information is processed for uses beyond your direct medical care – *secondary uses*. Examples of secondary uses include population health management and commissioning.

Microsoft makes data outputs available, to various third parties, in clearly identifiable, pseudonymised, and anonymised formats.

The personal confidential information disclosed from the surgery to Graphnet, for such purposes, **is not anonymised** by us prior to transfer.

It is your clearly identifiable, personal confidential information, and consists of - almost - your entire GP record.

The personal confidential information disclosed from Graphnet, for such purposes, to Microsoft, **is not anonymised** by them prior to transfer.

It is your clearly identifiable, personal confidential information, and includes - almost - your entire GP record.

Will I be asked before my GP records are uploaded to Microsoft?

NO. Unless you have opted out of Share Your Care *entirely*, your GP records will automatically be uploaded.

You will not be asked for your explicit permission first.

Is Oakley Health legally obliged to process data in this way.?

NO. Oakley Health Group is under no legal obligation to disclose personal confidential information for such secondary purposes.

It is entirely voluntary.

Does Oakley Health Group have [s251 approval](#) from the HRA's Confidentiality Advisory Group (CAG) for such disclosures?

NO. No such approval exists.

Will a Type 1 opt-out (prohibiting all secondary uses of my personal confidential information) or a National Data Opt Out prevent my information being disclosed and processed in this way?

NO. Connected Care respects neither the [Type 1 opt-out](#) nor the [National Data Opt Out](#).

You have the right to prohibit the upload of your information for these purposes if you wish; that is, *to opt-out*.

- If you have opted out, or now opt-out, of the Summary Care Record (SCR) then you will automatically be opted out of Share Your Care and Connected Care data analytics (secondary uses). You do not need to take any further action.
- If you have opted out of EMIS Web data streaming (for example, sharing of your GP record with Phyllis Tuckwell Hospice, NHS 111, or Frimley Community Services), then you will automatically be opted out of Share Your Care and Connected Care data analytics (secondary uses). You do not need to take any further action.

If you want to opt-out of Connected Care secondary uses then you will need to opt out of Share Your Care *entirely*.

That means prohibiting both direct care and secondary uses of your GP record.

There is no way to prohibit secondary uses within Connected Care whilst permitting direct care uses (i.e., allowing medical professionals outside of the surgery access to your GP record via Share Your Care).

Information about Share Your Care – *direct medical uses of your uploaded GP record* – [is in our factsheet](#).

Opting out of Share Your Care entirely will ensure that either no personal confidential information about you from your GP record is extracted and uploaded, or that any already uploaded information is deleted, and that no further information is uploaded – both to Share Your Care and to the Hampshire Health Record (CHIE).

Opting out of Share Your Care entirely will also ensure that no personal confidential information about you from other organisations or trusts is stored or maintained in either the Share Your Care or the Hampshire Health Record (CHIE) databases.

Your GP record, hospital record, community records, mental health records and social care records remain unaffected if you opt-out. They remain, as always, available to those organisations' clinical staff as required.
